Step 1: Place the rack as shown, limit the positions with the guide rail slots (the sides with ground connection nuts should face outward).



Step 4: Place the second layer rack, limit the positions with the guide rail slots, and fix the connecting strip (waist hole) to the bottom of the second layer rack. Note: The two adjacent layers of racks should be vertical aligned.

Step 2: Mount the connecting strip, fix the connecting strip (waist hole) to the bottom of the rack with M6 screws.



Step 5: Mount the racks in order to the required number of layers (up to three layers) according to the above method, ensure that the racks are aligned in all directions, then tighten the M6 screws (recommended torque 6N.m) on the rack connecting strip with a spanner.

Step 3: Mount the connecting strip, fix the connecting strip (round hole) to the top of the rack with M6 screws.



Step 6: Remove the guide rail, mount the side cover, fix the side cover to the connecting strip with M4 screws from the inner side.

Note: After the bottom side cover is fixed, the bottom surface should be even with the bottom of the rack (the connection strip's waist hole can slightly adjust the position of the top and bottom of the side cover).







Step 8: Mount the rear cover.





Note:

1.Before mounting the front cover, please install the modules in order from bottom to top, fix the modules and connect the relevant harnesses. 2.M8 expansion screw holes need to be reserved at the bottom of the rack, which can be installed and positioned according to your needs.



Step 10: Mount the front cover to complete the installation.
